

BINGO!!

In ~~August~~, we will be playing Fabric Bingo for fun. To play, you must prepare your "cards". I have attached the instructions as to how to make them. I will also bring a sample to a future meeting for you to see how they look when finished.

BINGO INSTRUCTIONS (Adapted from the Fons & Porter Magazine)

Here are the directions for making the Bingo Card:

Each column is one color group (Green, Blue, Purple, Red and Yellow to "orangish").

You may choose five different Fabric Patterns (Batik, dot, holiday, geometric, heart, plaid, solid, stripe or leaf) from each group except for the middle square which must be black for the "free" square.

Cut 2 ½ inch squares - you will need a total of 25 for one Bingo Card.

EXAMPLE

Column One - Green is the predominate color and can be batik, dot, holiday, solid etc. (from list above)

Column Two - Blue is the predominate color " " " "

Column Three - Purple " " " " " " "

Column Four - Red " " " " " " "

Column Five - Yellow to Orangish " " " " " " "

If, as you cut your squares you have extras, we can bring them to a meeting prior to our August 3 play date to exchange with others.

Use the scant quarter inch seam when you are sewing, so that we can collect the "cards" at the end of the day and someone can make them into charity quilts.

This is loads of fun and there will be prizes. Also, on the day of play, please bring buttons or pennies to use as your tokens.

Squares are 2 ½ inches square
