
How to: Pinwheel Star Quilt Block- 30 Days of Sewing Quilt Blocks- Star Version!

Hey guys! I hope you're having a great weekend. I fell off the wagon yesterday and didn't get a star quilt block tutorial posted, so you'll get two today. It was a busy day full of sewing, and spending time with my little family, you can check out what my day over on <u>Instagram</u>.

Anyways, today's quilt block tutorial is the **Pinwheel Star**. This block is super duper cute and will piece together quite quickly!

Cutting:

This block will finish at 12"x12" square.

White fabric:

4-3 1/2"x3 1/2" squares

2-37/8" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of these.

Gray fabric:

8-3 1/2"x3 1/2" squares

2-37/8"x37/8" squares

Sewing:



Place one white and one gray 3 7/8" square, right sides together.

Sew 1/4" on both sides of the draw line.

Trim on the draw line.

Press toward the darker fabric.

Repeat, make a total of four half square triangle blocks.



Sew two 3 1/2" gray squares, one white and gray half square triangle block and one 3 1/2" gray square.

Press.


Make two of these units, exactly the same.



Sew one gray and white half square triangle unit, two white 3 1/2" squares and one gray 3 1/2" square.

Press.

Make two of these units, exactly the same.



Sew the four rows together.

Press.


Now, to make this into a 96"x96" quilt you'll need the following fabrics:

Gray fabric:

6 5/8 yards

White fabric:

4 1/8 yards



Super cute quilt isn't it!!!
